

## Additional List to Draft NRC under Clause 5 of the Schedule of The Citizenship Rules, 2003



Additional list to **Draft NRC** published on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019 **DOES NOT CONTAIN** results of disposal of Claims and Objections

An Additional Exclusion List to Draft NRC has been published on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 containing ONLY the names of those persons who figured in the Complete Draft NRC published on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 but are subsequently found ineligible for inclusion on account of being:

- 1. Ineligible found during verification carried out under Clause 4(3) of the Schedule due to any reason including DV (Doubtful Voter) or DF (Declared Foreigner) or PFT (persons with cases Pending at Foreigners Tribunals) or their descendants, as applicable, discovered after publication of Draft NRC.
- 2. Ineligible found while appearing as witness in hearings held for disposal of Claims & Objections.

The Public can view the **Draft Additional List** as follows (During office hours):

- 1. At Designated NRC Seva Kendra (NSK)
- 2. At Office of the Deputy Commissioner/ SDO (Civil)/ Circle Officer where the Additional List for the village(s)/ward(s) is available in a consolidated manner.
- 3. For online viewing, the Complete Draft NRC viewing link in the NRC website www.nrcassam.nic.in to be clicked. Those persons whose Draft Status is changed to exclusion by Additional List, it is highlighted therein as "Excluded in Additional List". Those persons already included in Draft NRC published on 30th July, 2018 and not getting affected by Additional List will continue to be displayed as before.

What if one finds his/her name enlisted in the Additional list (exclusions) under Clause 5?

Those persons who will be excluded will be informed individually through Letters of Information (LOI) to be delivered at their residential addresses. Such persons will have the opportunity to file their Claims which will be disposed through a hearing by a Disposing Officer. The submission of Claim and disposal by Disposing Officer will happen together. LOI will mention the details of the venue of the hearing and submission of the Claim. All such Claims will be disposed thereafter before publication of Final NRC on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2019.

The entire process of NRC update is being carried out meticulously in a fair & objective manner and as per law under orders and close monitoring by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

All genuine Indian Citizens as per cut-off date 24th March, 1971 (midnight) will be included in the Final NRC
