■ Our NRC ▶

No genuine Indian Citizens will be left out. All Indian Citizens will be included in NRC with 24th March, 1971 (midnight) as the cut-off date as per provisions of Assam Accord

◆ Fair NRC ▶

NRC is impartial NRC is objective NRC is unbiased

- NRC is being updated in accordance with The Citizenship Act 1955 and The Citizenship Rules 2003
- The implementation of NRC is closely monitored by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India
- Deputy Commissioners as District Registrars of Citizen Registration (DRCRs) are the statutory officers responsible for NRC update in their districts

◀ Transparent Process ▶

- ✓ In case of doubt in any document or particulars submitted in the application, Verification Team from NSK will visit the applicant at their residential address
- √ Applicants will be given adequate opportunity to clear any doubts

Only one List -No categorisation >

✓ Draft NRC or Final NRC will only have a list of Indian Citizens, with no categorisation such as 'Original Inhabitant' or otherwise

66 What if my name is not included in draft NRC?

- 1. There is further opportunity by way of submission of claims immediately after publication of draft list for a period up-to 30 days
- 2. There will be a provision for filing objections
- 3. Separate publicity will be done on the process of filing claims and objections
